MAIN DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- To perform general kitchen duties as directed by the Cook and Housekeeper including
 - Making sure food preparation areas are clean and hygienic
 - Cleaning food preparation equipment, floors and other kitchen tools or areas
 - Washing and safely storing utensils and dishes
 - Disposing of rubbish
 - Organising linen laundry
 - Cleaning the dining areas
 - Deep cleaning of kitchen equipment
 - Serving lunches to children and staff and helping tidy up afterwards
- To keep up to date with and comply with statutory Health and Safety/Food Hygiene policies and practise in the workplace



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- Maintain the high standards of food hygiene already in place
- To operate industrial and electronic cleaning and catering equipment given appropriate training
- To fully participate in training linked to the workplace including, though not limited to, Safeguarding Children and Vulnerable Groups, Health and Safety including COSHH (Control of Substances Hazardous to Health), Healthy School status, British Sign Language and Deaf Awareness
- To build positive and constructive relationships with members of the team, staff, children and young people
- To work with flexibility to provide cover for periods of absence in the Housekeeping Team
- To contribute to whole School activities such as Open/celebration Days, themed lunches

For all our catering roles experience is not required, just a genuine commitment to providing the best catering service to children and young people of all abilities. We will give full support and training including Foundation Food Hygiene and the opportunity to learn British Sign Language.

All staff must respect the rights, dignity and worth of all children and young people irrespective of their age, ability, sex, sexual orientation, gender, race or personal beliefs. All staff are expected to comply with the School's health and safety, child protection policies, procedures and practice when going about their day to day activities

All staff should be committed to the communication approach of the School which values British Sign Language and English Equally. All staff must be prepared to improve their own bilingual skills (whether this be improving their BSL or English skills) as well as helping others to do so. Staff must be committed to good working by hearing /deaf teams.
